Dear Iowa Utilities Board members Huser, Lozier, and Byrnes:

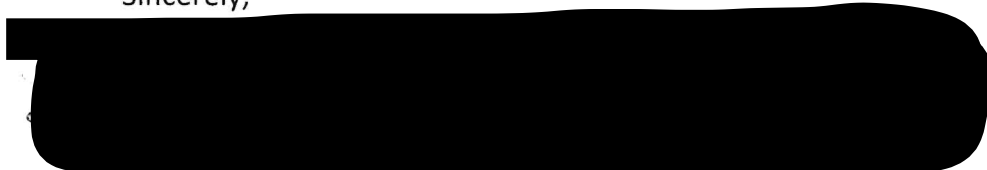
