We believe it's essential to understand how our operations will benefit the community. Summit Carbon Solutions (SCS) will be paying property taxes to Hardin County each year. These tax dollars will be used to support schools, health services, emergency services and other critical ongoing needs.



\$3,127,000

SCS will pay an estimated \$3,127,000 in property taxes paid to Hardin County each year.



~ \$1,365,000

Most of SCS's property taxes, \$1,365,000, will go to schools.



~ \$194,000

About \$194,000 will go to local community colleges.



~ \$360,000

\$360,000 will go to the various townships and cities.



~ \$1,208,000

Approximately \$1,208,000 goes to the General Fund to be used at the County's discretion.
